It IS A Mess!

Everyone agrees that four years is much too long for the houses flooded on Country Club Drive to be vacant. We think we may be closer to having the properties razed and turned into a greenbelt, but we can't promise anything as the funds for buying and dozing the properties remain concealed in a maze of bureaucracy. We understand that regulations did not allow for maintenance on the properties which then evolved into a messy health hazard and lingering eyesore. Government agencies were challenged by waves of mass destruction in Houston by Hurricane Harvey and state and federal funds for rural areas didn't receive priority. But enough is enough and, in September, the County Commissioner's Court placed the item on its agenda. Representatives from the MHPOA, Water District, Country Club, and area property owners met with a representative from the Texas General Land Office, County Judge Weber, County Commissioners, and several county staff to try to correct misinformation and voiced their shared frustrations over the delays in cleaning up the mess and eventually restoring this flood-prone area to greenbelt.

Changing personnel, and staff's interpretation of rules at the State level, have helped stall the processing of funding. For instance, before The Texas General Land Office, and Commissioner George P. Bush, could proceed with processing moneys earmarked for the project, the county was required to provide an environmental impact study and forensic appraisals of the properties' values before the flood. Reportedly, the revised paperwork for grant funding of the project has been submitted. In the meantime, county officials recently received permission from the State to mow and clean up the properties to help minimize the health hazards from infestations. Unfortunately, we have no idea when State funds will be released to demolish the buildings that have in effect been condemned.


Those attending are asked to bring a covered dish:
